2026 Official Rules

NO PURCHASE, PAYMENT, MEMBERSHIP, OR DONATION IS NECESSARY. A PURCHASE OR DONATION WILL NOT IMPROVE A STUDENT'S SCORE OR LIKELIHOOD OF SELECTION. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

By submitting a nomination, the nominating parent or legal guardian agrees to these Official Rules and to our decisions concerning administration of the program. All prizes are subject to eligibility verification and completion of the requirements described below.

1. Sponsor and Administrator

2. Program Period

Nominations open at **12:00 a.m. Eastern Time on Monday, August 10, 2026**, and close at **11:59 p.m. Eastern Time on Sunday, November 29, 2026**.

The first weekly selection is scheduled for Tuesday, August 18, 2026. The final weekly feature is scheduled for Tuesday, December 15, 2026, and the final monthly feature is scheduled for Friday, December 18, 2026.

All dates and times stated in these Official Rules are Eastern Time. Our computer system is the official timekeeping device for the program.

3. Eligibility

The program is open to students who, at the time of the applicable selection:

1. Reside in one of the 50 United States or the District of Columbia;
2. Are currently enrolled in kindergarten through Grade 12; and
3. Attend a public, private, charter, virtual, home-school, or other recognized kindergarten-through-Grade-12 educational program.

A nomination must be submitted by the student's parent or legal guardian. Students may not submit their own nominations.

A student who has graduated, withdrawn from school, or otherwise ceased to meet the eligibility requirements before the applicable selection is not eligible for that selection.

The following people and their immediate family or household members are not eligible:

- Employees, officers, directors, or board members of RLN Global, Inc. d/b/a Victory 91.5 and War Hill Christian Fellowship, Inc.;
- Volunteers, contractors, or judges of RLN Global, Inc. d/b/a Victory 91.5 and War Hill Christian Fellowship, Inc. who are involved in the program;
- Individuals directly involved in administering, managing, or judging the program on behalf of RLN Global, Inc. d/b/a Victory 91.5 or War Hill Christian Fellowship, Inc.; and
- Participating prize sponsors or underwriters and their employees who are directly involved in the program.

For purposes of these rules, "immediate family" includes a spouse, parent, child, sibling, and the spouse of any such person, regardless of where they reside.

All eligibility requirements are subject to verification.

4. How to Submit a Nomination

During the nomination period, a parent or legal guardian may nominate an eligible student by completing the form at:

<https://victory.radio/student-of-the-week>

The parent or legal guardian must complete all required eligibility, contact, and nomination fields and follow any word limits or instructions shown on the form.

Parents and guardians should not include unnecessary medical, financial, disciplinary, counseling, immigration, abuse-related, or other highly sensitive information in a nomination.

By submitting a nomination, the parent or legal guardian certifies that:

- They are the student's parent or legal guardian;
- They have authority to submit the nomination;
- The information provided is accurate to the best of their knowledge;
- They have read and agree to these Official Rules;
- We may contact them to administer the program and verify eligibility;
- De-identified nomination information may be independently scored by a human judge and an artificial-intelligence scoring tool; and
- If the student is selected, the parent or guardian and student will complete the interview, consent, and release requirements described in these rules.

5. Nomination Limit, Duplicates, and Withdrawal

There is a limit of **one nomination per student** during the 2026 program.

If we receive more than one nomination for the same student, we may retain the earliest complete eligible nomination and reject or remove later duplicates. Multiple nominations will not increase a student's score or likelihood of selection.

A nomination may not be substantively revised or replaced after submission.

A parent or legal guardian may withdraw a nomination by emailing support@victory.radio. Once processed, the nomination will be removed from all future weekly and monthly selections.

6. Selection Cutoffs

For a nomination to be considered during a particular weekly or monthly selection, it must be received by **11:59 p.m. Eastern Time two calendar days before the applicable selection date**.

Because scheduled selections take place on Tuesdays, the applicable cutoff will generally be the preceding Sunday at 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time.

A nomination received after a particular cutoff will not be considered for that selection but may be considered during later applicable selections, provided it is received before the final nomination deadline.

7. Weekly and Monthly Nomination Pools

We will maintain separate eligibility pools for weekly and monthly selections.

Weekly Eligibility

An eligible nomination will remain in the student's applicable weekly grade-band pool until:

- The student becomes a verified weekly winner;
- The student becomes a verified monthly winner;

- The nomination is withdrawn;
- The student becomes ineligible;
- The nomination is disqualified; or
- The final applicable weekly selection is completed.

A verified weekly winner will be removed from all future weekly selections.

Monthly Eligibility

All eligible nominations will remain in the monthly pool, including nominations for students who have already received a weekly prize.

A verified weekly winner will remain eligible for each remaining monthly selection unless:

- The student becomes a verified monthly winner;
- The student becomes ineligible;
- The nomination is withdrawn or disqualified; or
- The final monthly selection is completed.

A verified monthly winner will be removed from all remaining weekly and monthly selections.

A student may receive no more than:

- **One weekly prize; and**
- **One monthly prize.**

A student who receives a weekly prize may later receive one monthly prize.

Nominations will not carry over into a Student of the Week program conducted after the 2026 program concludes.

8. Weekly Grade Bands

Weekly selections will rotate among the following grade bands:

1. Kindergarten through Grade 2;
2. Grades 3 through 5;
3. Grades 6 through 8; and
4. Grades 9 through 12.

Only weekly-eligible nominations in the designated grade band will be considered for that week.

The student's grade band will be based on the grade stated in the accepted nomination. A nomination will not automatically move into another grade band during the 2026 program.

9. Merit-Based Judging Criteria

This is a merit-based contest. Students will not be selected randomly, and chance will not be used to select a winner or resolve a tie.

Each nomination will be evaluated using the following criteria:

Judging category	What we will evaluate	Weight
Student's Personal Action	How clearly the nomination describes a specific action and what the student personally chose, attempted, contributed, created, improved, or completed	30%
Positive Quality Demonstrated	How strongly the action demonstrates a positive quality such as kindness, character, integrity, effort, creativity, responsibility, courage, perseverance, compassion, or personal growth	30%
Meaning or Positive Difference	Why the action mattered, whom it affected, what changed, or why the accomplishment was personally meaningful	25%
Exceptional for the Student's Age	How strongly the action stands out when considered in relation to the student's age, grade, developmental stage, and reasonable opportunities	15%
Total		100%

Each category will receive a raw score from zero through five:

Score	Standard
5	Exceptional for the student's age and supported by a clear, meaningful example
4	Strong and clearly above ordinary expectations for the student's age
3	Positive and commendable, with sufficient supporting information
2	Some positive evidence, but the example is limited or unclear
1	General praise with little specific supporting information
0	No relevant or scorable information

The raw score for each category will be multiplied as follows:

- Student's Personal Action: raw score multiplied by 6, for a maximum of 30 points;
- Positive Quality Demonstrated: raw score multiplied by 6, for a maximum of 30 points;
- Meaning or Positive Difference: raw score multiplied by 5, for a maximum of 25 points; and
- Exceptional for the Student's Age: raw score multiplied by 3, for a maximum of 15 points.

An action does not need to involve formal leadership, a major award, a large service project, a dramatic hardship, or a large number of people to receive a high score. A quiet or everyday action may receive a high

score when it demonstrates exceptional character, effort, growth, responsibility, creativity, courage, or kindness for the student's age.

We will not award or deduct points based on:

- Grammar, spelling, vocabulary, or writing style;
- Emotional or persuasive writing;
- The length of a response, provided it contains sufficient information;
- The student's popularity;
- The number of nominations received;
- The student's school type or school attended;
- Church membership, denomination, or religious affiliation;
- Family income;
- Listener, donor, volunteer, sponsor, or underwriter status;
- Purchases or donations; or
- The parent or guardian's writing ability.

10. Human and AI Scoring

We will remove identifying information from the material provided for scoring to the extent reasonably practical.

The scoring material may include:

- An anonymous nomination number;
- The student's grade or grade band;
- The student's age range; and
- The written nomination responses.

The student's name, parent or guardian's name, contact information, mailing address, photograph, and school name will not be provided to the human judge or AI scoring tool. We may redact identifying details that appear within a written response.

Each eligible nomination will receive:

1. One independently assigned score from an authorized human judge; and
2. One independently generated score from an AI scoring tool using the same published criteria.

The human score and AI-generated score will each have a maximum of 100 points. The two scores will be added together and divided by two to calculate the nomination's final score.

For example:

- Human score: 88
- AI-generated score: 84
- Final score: 86

We will use substantially consistent scoring instructions throughout the program.

Each eligible nomination will ordinarily be scored once. Its score will remain in effect for later applicable weekly and monthly selections unless we identify and correct a clerical, calculation, eligibility, or technical error.

An authorized human administrator will verify eligibility, calculations, rankings, and application of these Official Rules.

If the AI scoring tool is unavailable, produces an incomplete or nonresponsive result, experiences a technical failure, or cannot reliably score a nomination, we may replace the AI-generated score with a score from an additional human judge using the same criteria.

11. Weekly Winner Selection

For each weekly selection, eligible nominations in the designated grade band will be ranked from highest to lowest according to their final scores.

The highest-scoring weekly-eligible nomination in that grade band will be the potential weekly winner, subject to:

- Eligibility verification;
- A timely response from the parent or legal guardian;
- Completion of the required interview;
- Completion of the required consent and release forms; and
- Acceptance of the prize.

There is no minimum qualifying score. If at least one eligible nomination is available in the designated grade band, the eligible nominations will be ranked under the published criteria.

If there are no eligible nominations in the designated grade band, we may skip that weekly selection and award no weekly prize. The published rotation will then proceed to the next scheduled grade band.

12. Monthly Winner Selection

Each monthly selection is open to all monthly-eligible nominations from kindergarten through Grade 12.

This includes students who have previously received a weekly prize but have not received a monthly prize.

The highest-scoring monthly-eligible nomination will be the potential monthly winner, subject to the same verification, response, interview, release, and prize-acceptance requirements that apply to weekly winners.

Monthly winners will be selected using the same merit-based criteria and human-plus-AI scoring process used for weekly selections.

When a monthly and weekly selection occur on the same date:

1. We will complete the monthly selection first;
2. The monthly potential winner will be removed from consideration for that day's weekly selection;
and
3. We will then complete the applicable weekly grade-band selection.

A student will not be selected as both the monthly and weekly winner on the same selection date.

13. Tie-Breaking

If two or more nominations receive the same final score, the tie will be resolved in the following order:

1. Higher combined score for Positive Quality Demonstrated;
2. Higher combined score for Exceptional for the Student's Age;
3. Higher combined score for Meaning or Positive Difference; and
4. Independent review of the tied nominations by an additional human judge using the same published criteria.

If the additional human judge assigns the same total score to the tied nominations, that judge will apply the same category order listed above.

No random drawing, coin toss, random-number generator, or other chance-based procedure will be used to resolve a tie.

14. Weekly Prizes

Each verified weekly winner will receive:

- Victory 91.5 Student of the Week recognition;
- Victory 91.5 apparel or a comparable prize item;
- An opportunity to participate in a photograph and recorded feature, subject to completion of the required releases; and
- Any additional prize or prize-pack option identified in the applicable Weekly Prize Notice.

The anticipated approximate retail value of the tangible weekly prize package is approximately **\$30** and will generally be between **\$25 and \$50**.

Before each applicable nomination cutoff, we will post a Weekly Prize Notice at <https://victory.radio/rules> identifying:

- The exact prize or available prize-pack choices;
- The approximate retail value;
- Any participating sponsor;
- Any material redemption or claim requirements; and
- Any applicable expiration date.

15. Monthly Prizes

Each verified monthly winner will receive the prize or choice of prize packs identified in the applicable Monthly Prize Notice.

The anticipated approximate retail value of a monthly prize is approximately **\$800** and will generally be between **\$600 and \$900**.

Before each applicable nomination cutoff, we will post a Monthly Prize Notice at <https://victory.radio/rules> identifying:

- The exact prize or available prize-pack choices;
- The approximate retail value;
- Any participating sponsor;
- Any material redemption or claim requirements; and
- Any applicable expiration date.

16. Prize Conditions and Substitutions

We will be responsible for providing the prizes. We may acknowledge a participating business, underwriter, donor, or other sponsor in connection with a prize.

A student's or family's relationship with a sponsor, underwriter, advertiser, donor, or our organization will not affect eligibility or scoring.

When multiple prize-pack choices are offered, the verified winner may select from the options identified in the applicable Prize Notice, subject to availability.

Prizes are nontransferable unless we provide written approval. No cash alternative will be provided.

If an announced prize or prize-pack option becomes unavailable, we may substitute:

- A gift card of comparable value; or
- Another prize or prize package of equal or greater approximate retail value.

The actual retail value of a prize may vary. A winner will not receive cash or another payment for any difference between the stated approximate retail value and the actual value.

Any applicable federal, state, or local taxes are the responsibility of the winner or the winner's parent or legal guardian. We may request information or documentation reasonably necessary to satisfy applicable tax-reporting requirements.

17. Winner Notification

We will send an initial notification email to the selected student's parent or legal guardian using the email address provided in the nomination.

The email will state that the student has been selected as a potential winner, subject to verification and completion of the required interview and release forms. The email will instruct the parent or guardian to reply and schedule either an in-studio or video interview.

We may also attempt to contact the parent or guardian by telephone.

The parent or guardian must reply to the initial notification email within **48 calendar hours after the email is sent**.

The parent or guardian is responsible for providing accurate contact information and monitoring email, including spam or junk-mail folders.

If the parent or guardian does not reply within 48 calendar hours:

- The potential winner may be disqualified;
- The nomination may be removed from all remaining weekly and monthly selection pools; and
- We may contact the next highest-scoring eligible nomination.

18. Required Interview and Release Forms

The student and the student's parent or legal guardian must both participate in one of the following:

1. An in-person interview at the Victory 91.5 studio; or
2. A live video interview arranged by us.

The interview must be scheduled as part of the parent or guardian's response to the initial notification email.

Unless we approve a reasonable extension, the interview must be completed within **five business days after the parent or guardian replies** and before the applicable feature date.

At the interview, the parent or legal guardian must complete all required:

- Eligibility confirmations;
- Prize-acceptance documents;
- Parent or guardian consent forms;
- Photograph releases; and
- Media and interview releases.

For a video interview, we may require the forms to be completed electronically before the recording begins.

If the student is 18 years old or older, the student must also personally consent to the interview and sign any applicable releases.

We may reasonably extend an interview or document deadline because of illness, technical problems, an emergency, or another circumstance we determine appropriate, provided the extension does not materially interfere with the scheduled feature.

A student is not a verified winner until:

- Eligibility has been confirmed;
- The parent or guardian has responded on time;
- The required interview has been completed with the student and parent or guardian present;
- All required forms and releases have been completed; and
- The prize has been accepted.

If these requirements are not completed by the applicable deadline, we may disqualify the potential winner, remove the nomination from all remaining pools, and contact the next highest-scoring eligible nomination.

19. Effect of Verification on Future Eligibility

Once a student is verified as a **weekly winner**:

- The student will be removed from all future weekly selections;
- The student will remain eligible for every remaining monthly selection; and
- The student may receive one monthly prize if later selected.

Once a student is verified as a **monthly winner**:

- The student will be removed from all future monthly selections; and
- The student will be removed from any remaining weekly selections.

A student who receives a weekly prize and later receives a monthly prize may receive both prizes.

20. Prize Pickup or Delivery

We will determine whether a physical prize will be:

- Provided during an in-studio interview;
- Made available for pickup at the studio;
- Shipped to the verified United States mailing address provided by the parent or guardian; or
- Delivered electronically, when applicable.

A family that completes a video interview will not be required to travel to the studio solely to claim a shippable or electronically deliverable prize.

Unless a different deadline is stated in the applicable Prize Notice, a prize requiring pickup must be collected within **30 calendar days after the student's feature date**.

Before verification, failure to respond, complete the interview, execute the releases, or satisfy the eligibility requirements may result in selection of an alternate.

After a student has been verified and featured, failure to pick up, receive, redeem, or use a prize by the applicable deadline will result in forfeiture. We will not be required to select a replacement after the original winner has been verified and featured.

21. Publicity

We will not publish the student's photograph or recorded interview until the required parent or legal guardian media release has been completed.

Subject to the completed release, we may use the student's:

- First name;
- Grade;
- School and/or county;
- Photograph;
- Nomination story; and
- Interview recording.

Approved information may appear:

- On our broadcast;
- At victory.radio;
- On our social-media accounts;
- In our email communications;
- In promotional materials for the Student of the Week program; and
- In materials identifying or acknowledging a participating prize sponsor.

We may edit a nomination story or interview for length, clarity, grammar, broadcast standards, or technical requirements, provided the substance is not materially changed.

The separate media release will control the permitted scope and duration of our use of the student's name, image, voice, story, and other approved information.

22. Privacy and Use of Nomination Information

Information submitted through the nomination form may be used to:

- Determine eligibility;
- Detect duplicate nominations;
- Administer the program;
- Score and rank nominations;
- Contact parents or guardians;
- Schedule and conduct interviews;
- Verify and deliver prizes;
- Meet legal or tax obligations; and
- Publicize a verified winner, subject to the required release.

Before scoring, we will remove names, contact information, school names, addresses, photographs, and other identifying information to the extent reasonably practical.

De-identified nomination responses, along with the student's grade and age range, may be processed by an AI service provider for the scoring described in these Official Rules.

We may retain nomination, judging, verification, and prize records for a reasonable period for program administration, legal compliance, dispute resolution, and recordkeeping.

23. Delays, Missed Selections, and Program Changes

If a selection or feature is delayed because of a holiday, emergency, technical problem, station scheduling, staff availability, or another circumstance outside our reasonable control, we may move it to the next reasonably available business day.

When a weekly grade-band selection is postponed rather than canceled, that grade band will remain the next grade band considered.

If there are no eligible nominations in a scheduled weekly grade band, we may skip that weekly selection and proceed to the next grade band in the published rotation.

If there are no monthly-eligible nominations, we may skip that monthly selection and award no monthly prize.

We may suspend, modify, postpone, cancel, or end all or part of the program when reasonably necessary because of:

- Legal or regulatory requirements;
- Fraud or attempted manipulation;
- Technical failures;
- Emergencies;
- Insufficient eligible nominations;
- Prize unavailability;
- Circumstances outside our reasonable control; or
- Circumstances that materially affect the integrity or administration of the program.

Any material change will be posted at <https://victory.radio/rules> and announced on air as required.

24. Disqualification and Technical Conditions

We may disqualify a nomination that:

- Is incomplete;
- Contains materially inaccurate, misleading, or unverifiable information;
- Exceeds the nomination limit;
- Was submitted without proper parental or legal authority;
- Contains unlawful, threatening, defamatory, obscene, or inappropriate material;
- Attempts to manipulate the judging or entry process;
- Uses automated methods to submit nominations;

- Violates these Official Rules; or
- Cannot be administered or verified as required.

We are not responsible for:

- Lost, late, delayed, misdirected, damaged, incomplete, or corrupted nominations;
- Incorrect or nonfunctioning contact information;
- Email filtered into spam or junk-mail folders;
- Website, server, network, telephone, software, or hardware failures;
- Unauthorized intervention in the nomination or scoring process; or
- Human, clerical, electronic, or technical errors.

We may correct a clerical, calculation, data-processing, or technical error without changing the substance of an otherwise valid nomination.

25. General Conditions and Limitation of Liability

Participation constitutes the parent or legal guardian's agreement to these Official Rules and to our decisions regarding eligibility, duplicate nominations, administration, scoring calculations, tie-breaking, verification, deadlines, scheduling, and prize fulfillment.

Our decisions are final, subject to applicable law.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the nominating parent or legal guardian agrees that we and our officers, directors, employees, volunteers, contractors, agents, sponsors, underwriters, and service providers are not responsible for claims, losses, injuries, or damages arising from participation in the program or the acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of a prize, except for claims that cannot lawfully be waived.

The program is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

26. Governing Law

To the extent permitted by applicable law, these Official Rules and any dispute arising from the program will be governed by the laws of the State of Georgia, without regard to conflict-of-law principles.

Any legal action concerning the program must be brought in a state or federal court having jurisdiction in Forsyth County, Georgia, except where applicable law requires otherwise.

27. Social-Media Disclaimer

The program is not sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with Facebook, Instagram, YouTube, or any other social-media platform.
